

OFFICIAL MINUTES

The Le Grand City Council held a Special Meeting at the Monet Center at 7:30 p.m., March 26, 2024 with Mayor Jodi L. Abrahams presiding. Roll call: Judy Cecak, Todd Parrish, Tyler Sawyer, Troy Underhill, Don Weitzell. Also Attending: KyLee Stone-City Clerk/Treasurer, Rod Fehrmann-Public Works. No citizens. Approval of Agenda: T Underhill motioned to approve agenda; seconded by T Parrish. Roll Call 5-0. Carried. Resolution No. 23-2024: A Resolution Fixing a Date for a Public Hearing for the Adoption of Budget and Certification of Taxes for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2024. J Cecak motioned to approve Resolution No. 23-2024 with a hearing date of April 16, 2024 at 7:00 PM at the Monet Center. Seconded by D Weitzell. Roll Call: 5-0. Carried.

Discussions about employee wages for FY25 occurred. A member from the Personnel Committee, T Underhill and a member of the Finance Committee, J Cecak met and discussed different options for wages in the prior week. T Underhill said the full-time Public Works employee should receive a dollar increase, the part-time Public Works, Deputy Clerk and City Clerk should not receive an increase at this time. T Sawyer disagreed to the employees who would receive no increase and thought at a minimum they should get a cost-of-living increase. T Underhill made a motion that the full-time Public Works employee should receive a \$1 increase in his hourly rate for FY25. Seconded by J Cecak. Roll Call: 5-0. Carried. T Underhill motioned that part-time Public Works employee receive no increase at this time. Seconded by D Weitzell. Roll Call: 5-0. Carried. D Weitzell motioned that the part-time seasonal Public Works employee receive no increase at this time. Seconded by T Underhill. Roll Call: 5-0. Carried. T Sawyer motioned that the City Clerk receive a \$1,500.00 increase to her salary. No second, motion dies. T Sawyer motioned that the Deputy Clerk receive a \$.50 cent increase. No second, motion dies. Mayor J Abrahams asked for a motion for Resolution No. 24-2024: A Resolution Approving Wages for City Employees for Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2025. T Underhill motioned to approve Resolution No. 24-2024 with a \$1 increase in hourly rate, making it \$24.60 per hour, for the full-time Public Works employee for FY25. Seconded by T Parrish. Roll Call: 5-0. Carried
