Trap Neuter Return

In a Trap-Neuter-Return program, community cats are humanely trapped, brought to a veterinarian to be spayed or neutered, vaccinated, ear-tipped and then returned to their outdoor home.

TNR has been proven to be the most successful method of reducing outdoor cat populations. Because spayed or neutered cats are taking up resources and not reproducing, the population lowers over time. Trapping and euthanizing allows more cats to move in to the territory to reproduce; therefore, it results in not being an effective solution.

If you see an ear-tipped cat, it is a Le Grand community cat in the TNR program.
